

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

June 2015

Services

We got unofficial notification that we will be once again receiving Bullet Aid money from Senator Marcellino. I would like to go back to our schedule of publishing our newsletter bi-monthly instead of quarterly using these funds. It has been difficult to plan so far ahead. The cost would be approximately \$900 per issue and \$150 in postage for each of the two additional newsletters.

Unfortunately we have not been able to order the 3Doodlers as they do not provide a purchase order account as of yet and our credit card does not have a big enough credit line. I am looking into purchasing them elsewhere.

Finances

We received \$1687.50, the balance of our Special Legislative Grant from Assemblyman Lavine.

We received \$7,524, the balance of our NYS Construction Grant.

Included in this Warrant is the bill for Member Library Support of NLS, \$3.522 which was approved in June 2014.

We received \$60 from a raffle held @ the Village Wine Merchant during Springfest for the benefit of the library.

Library survey

We received 122 responses to our online library survey. 1495 surveys were delivered; 397 (26%) were opened. The responses were overwhelming positive. We are working on some of the suggestions made. I will distribute copies of the Survey Responses at the meeting as the spreadsheets are quite large.
