### Programs

We are looking into a Museum Pass for the Whitney Museum. So far, they haven't been very interested but our representative is working on this.

Our new copy machine has been installed.

The Centennial/Grand Reopening Party was quite successful. A good time was had by all.

We will have a presence at the Beach beginning at the end of June.
